

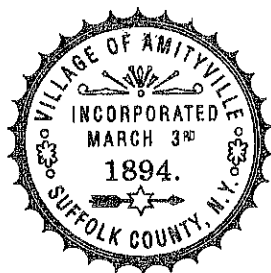

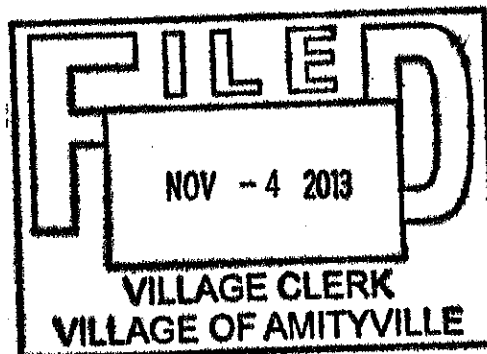

**Local Law No. 3 of the year 2013**

**A local law** to amend Section 43-5 A. of the Village Code to include the 9/11 Memorial Park.

**Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the**

County     City     Town     Village

**of Amityville as follows:**

**Section 1.** The Board of Trustees finds upon the recommendation of the Chief of Police that it is necessary to regulate the opening and closing hours for the 9/11 Memorial Park to prevent vandalism and damage to Village-owned property in the Park.

**Section 2.** Section 43-5A. of the Code of the Village of Amityville is hereby amended to read as follows:

“A. No person shall be permitted within the municipal bathing beach, the 9/11 Memorial Park, Peterkin Park, Pearsall Park, James A. Caples Park, Amityville Kiwanis Park or the Nautical Park at any time other than between the opening and closing hours thereof. The opening and closing hours of the beach and each municipal park shall be set by the Board of Trustees by resolution”

**Section 3.** This local law shall be effective immediately.


